

The 320± acre property has been developed using quality architectural custom log-style construction for all three structures: the owner's residence, caretaker's home, and maintenance shop. The property extends from a ridge top at an elevation of 1,000± feet, providing unobstructed views from both homes west to Cape Meares and its magnificent headland and 1890 historic lighthouse, south to Cape Lookout, north to

Tillamook Bay, and to the mouth of the Columbia River which is 40 miles to the north. The balance of the land that extends to the Three Capes Scenic Highway is managed as a tree farm, and contains an estimated three million board feet of primarily hemlock timber.

Portland is a two-hour drive, and the Port of Tillamook Airport, which can accommodate corporate jet aircraft, is a 25-minute
